# Background and scope of the research

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## Background of the research

The healthcare industry witnessed a rapid increase in IT and business process outsourcing adoption in recent years. Regulatory reform, consumerization of healthcare, market consolidation, and emergence of new technologies accelerated outsourcing in the healthcare market. A number and variety of service providers have developed capabilities to cater to this growing market.

With healthcare companies stepping up adoption of outsourced delivery, there is an uptick in demand for research and market intelligence on demand and supply trends in healthcare outsourcing across the three major market segments – payer, provider, and life sciences. The need is more pronounced for the vertical-specific IT outsourcing function, where business challenges are driving greater adoption. Everest Group's healthcare outsourcing research program addresses this market requirement by analyzing outsourcing trends and service provider capabilities specific to ITO in the healthcare vertical.

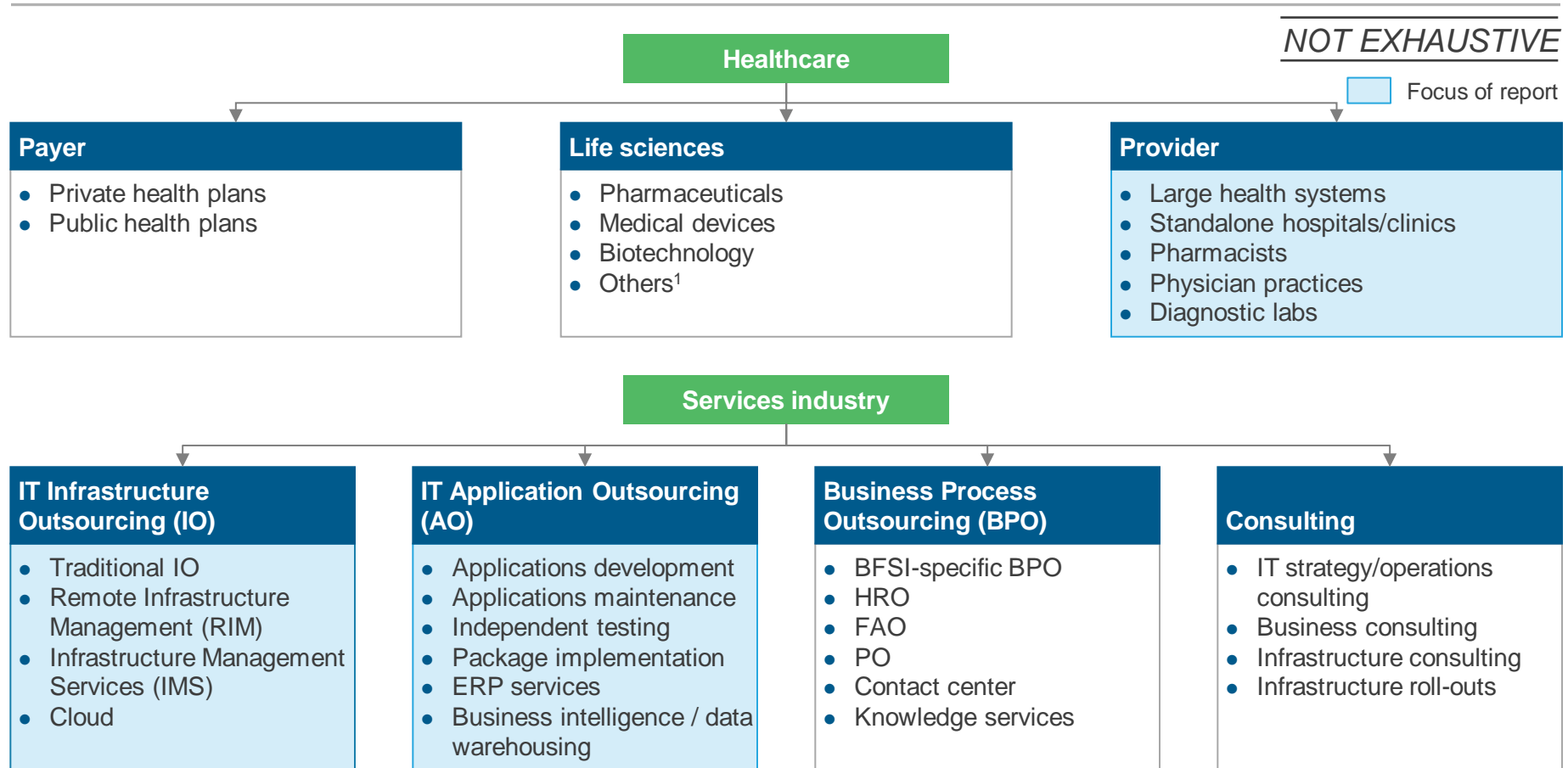

- **Geography:** Global
- **Sourcing model:** Third-party ITO transactions; excludes shared services or Global In-house Centers (GICs)

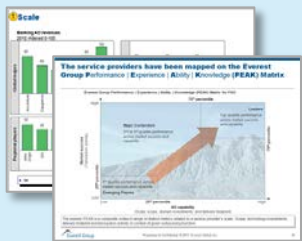

## Healthcare ITO market overview

- Growing ITO activity from public sector and government in the healthcare sector is an established trend
- Growth was witnessed from deals originating from Europe and in new contract signings globally

## Healthcare provider ITO market overview

- Regulatory reforms and customer-centricity are key factors driving ITO transaction activity; healthcare providers also withheld some ITO spending due to approaching reforms deadlines (from 2014), serving a lead indicator of future spurt in technology budgets
- Most of the IT transactions are driven by healthcare providers below US\$10 billion in revenue, making this the most active segment in terms of provider ITO transaction activity

- There are five key themes driving healthcare provider industry's IT investments
  - Analytics
  - EHR adoption
  - Payer-provider convergence
  - Compliance requirements
  - Digitization

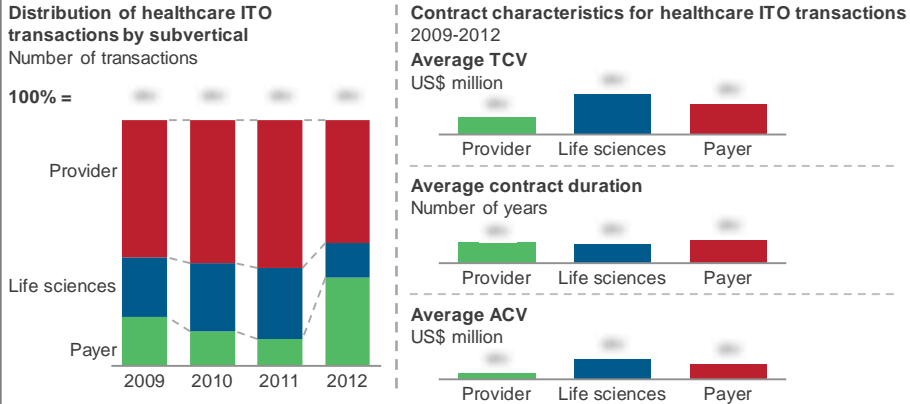
## Outlook for 2013-2014

- Large health systems and ACOs are expected to continue to dominate the ITO activity among provider subsegments

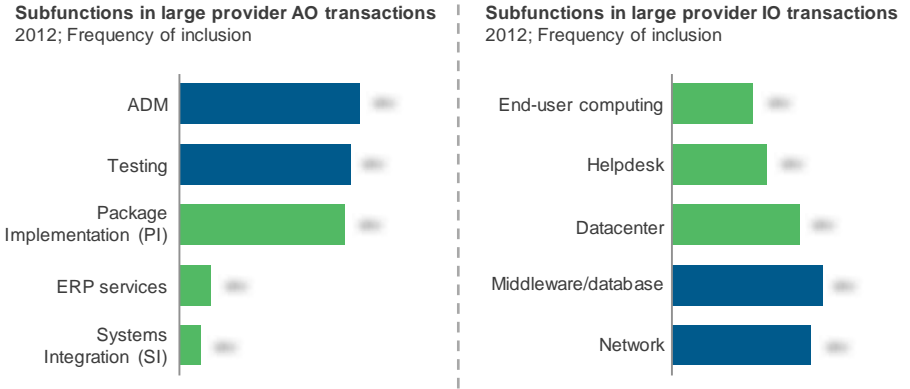

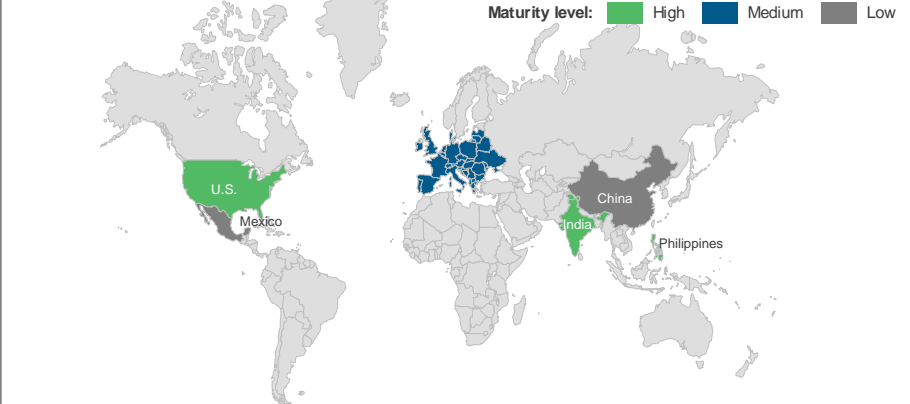
### ITO in healthcare provider industry vs. other healthcare segments



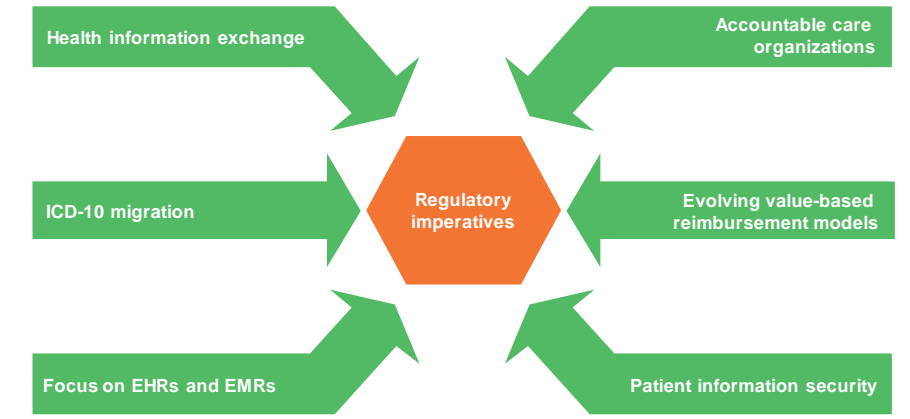
### Functional adoption of IT services
