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## Introduction

Medical coding is one of the most penetrated segments in terms of outsourcing in the Revenue Cycle Management (RCM) value chain. With the growing incidence of chronic diseases and the rising geriatric population, the demand for skilled medical coders is seeing an uptick. Rising demand for qualified coding staff combined with an in-house shortage of skilled personnel, owing to the coding population reaching retirement age and attrition, is driving growth for outsourcing medical coding services to third-party vendors.

Additionally, the transition from inpatient to home-based care delivery model, adoption of telehealth and remote patient monitoring, and addition of new code sets have increased the complexity quotient of medical coding processes. These gradual shifts have made medical coding a more judgment-intensive activity. Vendors are investing in cutting-edge technology to more successfully manage the talent crisis without sacrificing productivity and efficiency in the face of rising complexity to serve healthcare providers better.

### Strengths

- Provider has a decent pool of coders, who have a balanced focus on both outpatient and inpatient coding services. This will benefit the firm as healthcare providers reeling under talent shortages have become more open to outsourcing complex coding services
- The firm is focusing on technology to drive growth and improve operational efficiency. It launched XYZ, an analytics-based management tool designed to optimize operational workflows and enhance business intelligence capabilities. It also launched a new coding automation platform designed to increase productivity and accuracy

### Limitations

- Limited focus on expanding pre- and post-coding functions of the medical coding value chain is likely to put a cap on its growth in the medical coding segment
- While Provider has a decent number of coders in its workforce, majority of them are not certified by any credentialing organization. Even though it is not a mandate, having a team of certified coders who are recognized as domain experts indicates the firm's capabilities to handle judgment-intensive processes
- Provider delivers its medical coding services primarily from offshore locations. With an increase in outsourcing trends in the market, people-centric investments in onshore locations can increase its competitiveness in large deals where privacy and control over data is a major concern
