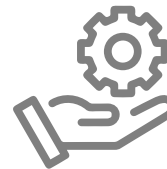

**Case study 1** Streamlined access request tickets and ensured regulatory compliance

**Client:** a large banking organization

**Business challenge**  
 The client was facing challenges in streamlining access request tickets as 70% of requests were handled through emails, causing significant delays in business operations. The IAM processes were complex and involved siloed teams, which led to inefficiencies and a backlog of requests. There was a lack of administrative access, that was essential for regulatory compliance. Additional application and service credentials posed security risks. Delays in access review caused regulatory compliance concerns, and the absence of SoD requirement level caused regulatory compliance issues.

**Solution**  
 Provider delivered new SailPoint IIQ, CyberArk, and 360+ application migration implementation and operations team in 36 months. It streamlined and automated siloed teams to boost efficiency and decrease business-impacting user access reviews and certification, enabling to meet compliance requirements in a timely manner.
