Introduction

The lending operations market has experienced significant turmoil in recent years due to high interest rates and other macroeconomic factors, leading to reduced consumer activity. Investments in digital lending solutions and tools are helping to streamline the end-to-end lending life cycle and significantly improve the overall customer experience.

Geographically, North America continues to dominate the lending market with a substantial share of new deals and investments. However, emerging markets in Asia Pacific,

the UK, and Continental Europe are rapidly gaining traction as lenders seek to tap into growing opportunities in these regions.

The market is also seeing increased interest from non-traditional providers, such as technology firms and real estate companies, further diversifying the competitive landscape.

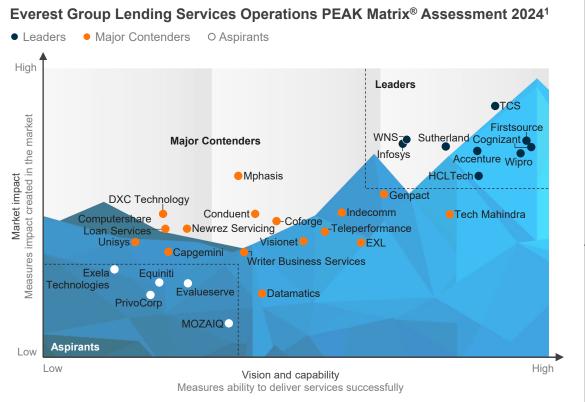

Limitations

- Provider 1 footprint in the North American market is in its early stages, where new wins in the intermediary segment have not been substantial enough to significantly expand its portfolio in the region
- · From a partnership standpoint, there is scope to collaborate with technology- and domain-specific partners to bring more innovative solutions to the intermediary segment and differentiate itself in the market
