### Background of the research

IDP products find a wide variety of use cases across different business functions and verticals. IDP adoption not only helps enterprises achieve cost savings but also improves their workforce productivity and employee and customer experience. IDP technology providers are increasingly offering low-code/no-code capabilities to enable citizen developers to configure the platform. They are enhancing their capabilities and functionalities and allowing users to interact with documents via natural language by integrating with Large Language Models (LLMs).

Each provider profile provides a comprehensive picture of its product overview, company overview, recent deals and announcements, and market adoption. The assessment is based on Everest Group's annual RFI process for the calendar year 2023, which involved interactions with 26 leading IDP technology providers. Among them, 20 participated in the RFI process, while 6 did not. The assessment included 10 leading IDP technology providers for banking-specific processes, 10 leading IDP technology

providers for insurance-specific processes, inputs from reference clients, and an ongoing analysis of the IDP technology market.

#### Some of the findings in this report, among others, are:


#### Key product features

- Most of the providers offer online marketplace for pre-trained models, leverage zero-shot/one-shot learning mechanism, and enable continuous feedback through human-in-the-loop (HITL) capability
- Some providers have also invested in generative AI to enhance software learning and training and offer generative Al-powered chat-interface to answer queries around analytics and generate reports to differentiate their offering
- Several providers offer the ability to perform summarization, sentiment analysis, and document comparison
- Some providers allow classification of documents and pages using Al/ML algorithms and use of multiple OCR engine
- Majority of the providers offer the ability to auto-redact sensitive information and enable role-based access control
- Many providers are partnering with OCR providers and for other complementary technologies, such as RPA and process orchestration, to meet the growing need for comprehensive automation solutions

#### Banking- and insurance-specific capabilities and offerings

- To strengthen the value proposition for banking-specific use cases, some IDP providers offer pre-built connectors for integration with LOS systems along with the ability to report anomalies and detect counterfeit documents
- Providers focusing on insurance-specific processes have invested in claims management and policy servicing features such as the ability to extract claims details from FNOL document and map it to the relevant policy
- Most of the providers support processing of a variety of documents including identity documents, emails, financial statements, loss run, and proof of premium payment
