Background of the research

The multi-process global HRO market is dominated by North America with around 70% of the deals originating there. However, despite some unique challenges in Europe, the European HRO market is seeing increased activities in recent times. In fact, in the last two years, its share of the global HRO market increased significantly. Moreover, post 2005, a majority of global transactions originated in Europe.

In this research study, we analyze the European HRO market across various dimensions that include:

- Market overview and trends
- Key market segments
- Transaction characteristics
- Supplier landscape and delivery capabilities

The scope and methodology of this report includes:

- Third-party HRO deals; it does not include shared services or captives
- Multi-process HRO deals with a minimum of three HR processes and servicing more than 3,000 employees
- All multi-process HRO deals signed as of December 2007
- Focused interviews with key HRO suppliers in Europe

Overview and abbreviated summary of key messages (page 1 of 2)



The European market has seen increased HRO adoption over the past couple of years. The changing dynamics in this market have led to increased demand, along with entrance of new "payroll-led" and "offshore-led" multi-process HRO suppliers. This report provides a comprehensive coverage of the Pan-European HRO market including detailed analyses on market size and trends, market segments, transaction characteristics, and supplier landscape and delivery capabilities.

Some of the findings in this report, among others, are:

Market overview and trends

- While the slowdown in the global HRO market impacted deal signing in Europe in 2007, its share of global HRO market increased significantly post 2005
- Europe presents unique challenges; however, both buyers and suppliers are taking steps to address them

Market segments

- The European market can be divided into three key regions based on their inherent characteristics that impact HRO adoption: UK and Ireland, Western Europe, and Central and Eastern Europe
- The >15K employees segment has seen most activity in Europe to date.
 Post 2005, the 3K-15K employees segment's share increased from 7% to 18%, in terms of TCV

Transaction characteristics


- Compared to North America, a fewer number of European HRO deals include core HRIS transformation and outsourcing
- The manufacturing and government /public sectors are the dominant verticals in the European HRO market, with their share climbing rapidly post 2005

Supplier landscape and delivery capabilities

- There are a number of suppliers in the European HRO market; some focusing on the UK market only while some have a pan-European focus
- Accenture and ExcellerateHRO are the current market leaders. However, several suppliers are emerging as major contenders
